

**Detailed rules on the enrolment procedure for graduate studies  
at Collegium Da Vinci in the academic year 2026/2027**

**§ 1**

**General provisions**

Detailed rules of the enrolment procedure at Collegium Da Vinci (hereinafter referred to as: the "University" or "CDV"), in the academic year 2026/2027 (hereinafter referred to as: "Detailed Rules"), contain a list of detailed requirements in the enrolment procedure for particular first-cycle, second-cycle programmes, a list of majors for which there is a limit of vacancies, a list of majors for which entrance is free (admission takes place after fulfilling formal requirements in accordance with the Enrolment Resolution by presenting required documents and paying the enrolment fee), the minimum number of qualifying points being a condition for admission, if the enrolment procedure provides for a point threshold, rules and dates for conducting qualifying examinations, if the enrolment procedure provides for conducting them, in accordance with § 3(4) of the " Terms and conditions, procedure and dates of commencement and termination of enrolment for graduate studies at Collegium Da Vinci in the academic year 2026/2027", which constitute an appendix to Resolution 1 of the Senate of Collegium Da Vinci of 08 December 2025 on the amendment of the terms, procedure and dates of commencement and termination of enrolment for graduate studies at Collegium Da Vinci in the Academic Year 2026/2027 (hereinafter referred to as the "Enrolment Resolution").

**§ 2**

**Detailed rules of admission to the studies**

1. Appendix No. 1 to the Detailed Rules contains a list of requirements and detailed rules on enrolment for particular first-cycle degree programmes at Collegium Da Vinci in the academic year 2026/2027.
2. Appendix No. 2 to the Detailed Rules contains a list of requirements and detailed rules on enrolment for particular second-cycle degree programmes at Collegium Da Vinci in the academic year 2026/2027.
3. In the event that the enrolment procedure provides for the conduct of examinations, including qualifying examinations, the composition and procedure of the Admission Boards shall be determined by the Rector by way of an order. The relevant order of the Rector shall be published on the website of the University and on the BIP website of Collegium da Vinci no later than 7 days before the day on which the boards are to work.

4. In the event the enrolment procedure provides for admission of candidates on the basis of a ranking list, candidates with the highest scores above the minimum point threshold in the enrolment procedure within the limit of vacancies for a given major are admitted to the studies, subject to para. 5.
5. In the event that a candidate resigns or fails to complete the enrolment procedure within the specified time limit, the next person on the ranking list obtains the right to be admitted and to take up studies, provided that he/she has passed the enrolment process.

### **§ 3.**

#### **Submission of documents**

1. Documents in the enrolment procedure shall be submitted in accordance with the provisions of the Enrolment Resolution.
2. If original documents are submitted by mail (including courier service), they can only be collected in person at the University after the enrolment procedure has been completed, subject to the provisions of para. 3 of this section.
3. In the event of non-admission to study at Collegium Da Vinci or discontinuation of the enrolment procedure, a candidate may apply for the original documents to be sent to the address given.

### **§ 4**

#### **Final provisions**

1. The Order shall come into force as of 15th January 2026.

1. There is a limit of vacancies for all first-cycle study programmes at Collegium Da Vinci in the academic year 2026/2027, and for some study programmes there is a ranking list created on the basis of the qualifying examination according to the rules indicated in the table.
