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Cooperation

By carrying out activities jointly with CDV, each employer has the opportunity to establish permanent business relations with both the academic community, students - i.e. potential employees, and other partners of the university through an extensive system of projects and networking meetings.

The Practicality Centre offers many opportunities for cooperation and implementation of joint ventures.

Our proposal is based on eight main pathways. It is up to the Partner to decide which of these it will follow together with CDV. So in which areas can we cooperate?

PARTNER OF THE MAJOR

each of the majors offered by CDV has a partner, i.e. a company which cooperates closely with the teaching staff, consults changes in curricula, organises workshops, work placements and internships for students, is involved in the development of the majors, i.e. in the training of its future employees.

WORKSHOPS

experts and specialists from partner companies are invited to hold workshops for students and graduates, owing to which, they can exert a real impact on the development of competences of their future employees.

CLASSES AND MENTORING

practitioners from companies are invited to conduct teaching activities as trainers and lecturers and to carry out monitoring programmes. As mentors and lecturers, they share their experience with students and have the opportunity to take part in projects aimed at the transfer of knowledge, ideas and experience.

CASE STUDY PROJECTS AND THESES

each partner of the major has the opportunity to provide a case study related to its company, which will be solved by the students during classes or as part of the thesis under the supervision of an experienced academic teacher, in cooperation with a company representative.

• WORK PLACEMENTS AND INTERNSHIPS

companies offering a work placement or internship programme can



verify the skills, knowledge and competences of our students while performing real-life tasks in their companies, and students have the opportunity to apply the knowledge they have gained in practice and acquire valuable work experience.

EMPLOYERS' COUNCIL

representatives of the most active partners are invited to sit on the Employers' Council, which plays an advisory role in the process of designing and modifying majors to meet the needs of the dynamically developing labour market.

DUAL STUDIES

this is a project in which some of the classes in a given major are implemented at the university and some within the framework of the projects completed at the employer's premises. Owing to this solution the studies are even more practical.

NETWORKING

partners of the majors are invited to thematic networking meetings during which they have the opportunity to establish cooperation with both students, graduates, academics as well as other companies.
